Visas

Nationals of the following countries do not need a visa to enter the Republic of Croatia or to stay in the country for up to three months, or for transit through the territory of the Republic of Croatia:

Albania, Andorra, Antigua and Barbuda, Republic of Argentina, Australia, Austria, Commonwealth of the Bahamas, Barbados, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Federal Republic of Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Republic of Bulgaria, Republic of Cyprus, Montenegro, Czech Republic, Republic of Chile, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, French Republic, Republic of Guatemala, Hellenic Republic, Republic of Honduras, Ireland, Iceland, State of Israel, Japan, Canada, Republic of Korea, Republic of Costa Rica, Republic of Latvia, Principality of Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, Hungary, Macedonia, Malaysia, Malta, Republic of Mauritius, United Mexican States, Principality of Monaco, Republic of Nicaragua, Netherlands, Norway, New Zealand, Federal Republic of Germany, Republic of Panama, Republic of Paraguay, Republic of Poland, Portuguese Republic, Romania, Republic of El Salvador, Republic of San Marino, Republic of Seychelles, Republic of Singapore, United States, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Serbia, Vatican, St. Kitts and Nevis, Kingdom of Spain, Kingdom of Sweden, Swiss Confederation, Republic of Italy, Republic of Turkey, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Eastern Republic of Uruguay, Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.

Visa is not required for bearers of valid travel documents issued by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland:

British (overseas) citizens;

British overseas nationals that have the right of residence in the UK and

British subjects who have the right of residence in the United Kingdom.

This also applies to holders of valid passports issued in the special administrative area of Hong Kong People's Republic of China and the Macao Special Administration Territory of the People's Republic of China.

Visa requirement does not apply to holders of passports issued in Taiwan, if the personal ID number is entered in the passport.

Aliens who are holders of:

- a residence permit issued by one of the Schengen Area member state
 - Schengen uniform visas (C) – valid for all Schengen countries or
 - long-stay visas (D) issued by one of the Schengen Area member state
- temporarily do not require a visa for entering and short-term stay or for transit through the territory of Croatia.

Nationals of Kosovo, who are holders of Schengen visas with limited territorial validity

(LTV visas), valid for all Schengen countries except for Greece and Spain, temporarily do not require a visa for entering and short-term stay or for transit through the territory of Croatia.

Croatia's visa policy is fully harmonized with that of the EU even before the accession (1 July 2013), as of 1 April. This means that from that date onwards the classic visa regime will apply for the citizens of Russia and Turkey as well as citizens of all those countries that need visa for entering the EU member countries.
